	<p>Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">T14S R48E ¼ <u>S 25</u> S 36</p> <p style="text-align: center;">1979</p> <p>set a steel fence post, 6 ft. long, 22 ins. in the ground, alongside the iron post.</p>
78.50	Wash, 20 lks. wide, 1 ft. deep, drains SSE.
80.06	<p>The cor. of secs. 25, 26, 35 and 36.</p> <p>Land, gently rolling. Soil, sandy and volcanic ash. Timber, none; undergrowth, creosote bush, shadscale and cactus.</p>
GENERAL DESCRIPTION	
<p>The portion of the township surveyed is an arid desert region and is located on the southeast tip of Yucca Mountain. The soil is sandy, with volcanic ash. The vegetation consists of creosote bush and shadscale, with scattered cactus.</p>
