in 1873,
and the Resurvey Executed by
J.R. Glover and G.H. Perrin,
U.S. Deputy Surveyors,
in 1881.

From the cor. of Tps. 6 and 7 N., Rs. 41 and 42 E.,
monumented with an iron post, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., firmly set
showing 6 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd. as
described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey
of the east boundary of T. 6 N., R. 41 E., executed
under Group No. 467.

N. $2^{\circ} 56'$ W., bet. secs. 31 and 36.

Over nearly level land, covered with scattered
shadscale, Mormon tea, sagebrush and native grass.

40.04 Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 31 and 36, at
proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence
of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 22 ins.
in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
