22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

iron post, firmly set in a collar of stone, with brass

From the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 9 and 10, monumented with  
a granite stone, 14x8x8 ins., dimly mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  on W. face,  
firmly set 8 ins. in a mound of earth.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 22 ins.  
in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
