

TOWNSHIP 5 NORTH, RANGE 46 EAST, MDM, NEVADA

CHAINS

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The land within Township 5 North, Range 46 East is about 6,500 to 7,100 ft. above sea level and is gently rolling to mountainous. The soil is sandy clay, gravelly and rocky.

The vegetation consists of sagebrush, greasewood and rabbitbrush, with a medium stand of juniper and pinon pine on the higher elevations.

The township is drained by Saulsbury Wash, which drains southerly through sections 28 and 33.

There is a ranch house in the northeast quarter of sec. 33.

Principal users of the area are cattlemen and access into the township is provided by improved and unimproved desert trail roads.

No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the survey.
