## GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The land within Township 24 North, Range 49 East, ranges from about 6,100 to 8,100 ft. above sea level, and is rolling to mountainous. The soil is sandy clay, gravelly and rocky. The vegetation consists of sagebrush, with medium to heavy juniper and pinon pine on the higher elevations.

The township is drained by Denay Creek, which winds northeasterly through the eastern portion of the township.

There is a ranch house in section 26.

Principal users of the area are cattlemen. Access throughout the township is provided by bladed and trail roads.

No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the survey.
