C. C. Tracy, U. S. Deputy Surveyor,
in 1868.

From the standard cor. of Tps. 25 and 26 N., Rs. 55 and 56 E., monumented with an iron post, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., firmly set and exposed 4 ins. above the ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of the Fifth Standard Parallel North, through a portion of R. 56 E., executed concurrently under T. 25 N., R. 56 E. of this same group.

N. $89^{\circ} 46'$ W., along the S. bdy. of sec. 36.

Over rolling land, covered with crested wheat grass.

33.90 Fence, bears NNW. and SSE.

39.91 Point for the standard $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 36, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
