

TOWNSHIP 7 NORTH, RANGE 26 EAST, MDM, NEVADA

CHAINS

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The land within Township 7 North, Range 26 East is about 5,600 to 6,700 ft. above sea level and is rolling to mountainous land. The soil is sandy clay loam along the bottom land and rocky on the high elevations. The land is covered with sagebrush and native grass except along the river bottom which is covered with meadow grass and Bull Berries.

There is a graded gravel road crossing from West to East, entering in sec. 30 and leaving in sec. 35.

The East Walker River enters the area in sec. 30 and leaves in sec. 35.

Principal users of the area are ranchers and farmers.

There was some mineral formations noted in secs. 26, 27, 34 and 35.
