CHAINS

The following field notes describe the dependent resurvey of a portion of the west boundary and a portion of the subdivisional lines, and the subdivision of section 3, of Township 27 North, Range 62 East, Mount Diablo Meridian, Nevada.

The history of surveys pertinent to this resurvey is as follows:

The boundaries and subdivisional lines were surveyed by Preble and Thorburn in 1881-1882, shown on the official plat of survey approved October 2, 1882. The boundaries and subdivisional lines were resurveyed by Eldon W. Sibley and Horace G. Parker in 1963-1964, shown on the official plat of survey accepted November 4, 1965.

This survey was done at the request of the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Phoenix Area office, by letters dated November 7, 1974 and January 16, 1975, for the purpose of defining the boundaries of the Te-Moak Indian Reservation (Odger's Ranch), Nevada.

The survey was executed in accordance with the specifications set forth in the Manual of Surveying Instructions, 1973, and the Special Instructions for Group No. 518, Nevada, dated March 7, 1975.

Preliminary to the resurvey, the lines of the original resurvey were retraced and search was made for all corners and other calls of the record. Identified corners were rehabilitated in their original positions. The retrace-ment data were thoroughly verified and only the true line field notes are given herein.

The directions of all lines refer to the true meridian and were determined by means of fore and back sights and angular deflections from azimuths obtained by direct solar observations. All lines were measured with a Hewlett-Packard, Model 3805, electronic distance measuring instrument. All lines not forming a closure were measured twice to preclude error.

The geographic position of the corner of sections 2, 3, 10, and 11, as scaled from the Bureau of Land Management resource map, "CURRIE, NEVADA", 30 minute series, dated 1972, is as follows:

Latitude 40° 14.3' N. Longitude 114° 57.6' W.

The mean magnetic declination is 16° 00' E.

Beginning at the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 6, on the W. bdy. of the tp., monumented with an iron post, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., firmly set, extending 4 ins. above ground, encircled by a collar of stone to top, with brass cap mkd.
