The N ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 1, on the N. bdy. of the Tp.,
monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., firmly set
showing 6 ins. above the ground, with brass cap mkd. as
described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey
of T. 24 N., R. 41 E., executed under Group No. 561.

Hereafter, this cor. will refer to Tps. 23½ and 24 N.,
R. 41 E., the brass cap was remarked as follows:
