## GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The land within Township  $23\frac{1}{2}$  North, Range 41 East is about 5,100 to 5,600 ft. above sea level and is level to rolling land. The soil is sandy clay along the bottom land and rocky on the high elevations. The land is covered with sagebrush and native grass.
