Hereafter, this cor. will refer to secs. 5 and 6 only.</p> <p>At the corner point</p> <p>Set an aluminum post, 30 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with aluminum cap mkd.</p> <div>S 6 S 5 T23N R40E</div> <p>1979</p> <p>Deposit the original wooden post alongside the aluminum post and raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, S. of cor.</p>
40.09	<p>S. 88° 49' W., along the N. bdy. of sec. 6.</p> <p>Over rolling land, through medium sagebrush, shadscale and bunchgrass.</p> <p>Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 6 and 31, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner. Hereafter, this cor. will refer to sec. 6 only.</p> <p>Set an aluminum post, 30 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with aluminum cap mkd.</p> <div>¼ S 6 T23N R40E</div> <p>1979</p> <p>Raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, S. of cor.</p>
