

TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH, RANGE 57 EAST, MDM, NEVADA

CHAINS

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The land within Township 16 South, Range 57 East, ranges from about 3,000 to 3,700 ft. above sea level, and is most rolling.

The soil varies from sandy gravel to rocky. The vegetation consists of creosote brush, greasewood, Spanish bayonet and Joshua trees.

U. S. Highway No. 95 crosses the area from SE. to NW. Further access into the township is provided by numerous secondary and desert trail roads.

A U. S. Air Force communication compound is situated in sec. 29.

No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the survey.
