The cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36, on the W. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with an aluminum post, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., firmly set in a mound of stone, with aluminum cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of T. 41 N., R. 19 E., executed concurrently under this same group.

From the cor. of secs. 29, 30, 31 and 32.

N. $0^{\circ} 25'$ E., bet. secs. 29 and 30.

Over gently rolling land, covered with medium sagebrush, rabbitbrush, scattered greasewood and native grass.

Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 29 and 30, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an aluminum post, 30 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with aluminum cap mkd.
