	<p>From the cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12, on the E. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with a porphyry stone, 17x10x7 ins., firmly set 7 ins. in the ground, mkd. with 5 grooves on the S. face and 1 groove on the N. face.</p> <p>At the corner point</p> <p>Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">T21N R42E R43E S 1 S 6 S 12 S 7</p> <p style="text-align: center;">1979</p> <p>Deposit the original cornerstone alongside the iron post and raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, W. of cor.</p> <p>N. 1° 07' E., bet. secs. 1 and 6.</p> <p>Over gently rolling land, covered with sagebrush and native grass.</p>
26.10	Trail road, bears NNW. and SSE.
38.20	Trail road, bears NNE. and SSW.
40.01	<p>Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 6, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.</p> <p>Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">T21N R42E R43E ¼ S 1 S 6</p> <p style="text-align: center;">1979</p> <p>Raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, W. of cor.</p>
