The soil is sandy clay loam along the bottom land and rocky in the higher elevations. The land is covered with sagebrush and native grass except along the river bottom which is covered with scattered meadow grass and the higher elevations which is covered with scattered to dense juniper.</div> <div>State Highway No. 8-A enters the township in section 35 and exits in section 2. There are numerous scattered trail roads throughout the township.</div> <div>The Reese River enters the township in section 35 and leaves in section 2 with a general northerly course.</div> <div>Principal users of the area are ranchers and farmers.</div> <div>There are some mining activities scattered throughout the township.</div>	
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
