

TOWNSHIP 34 NORTH, RANGE 59 EAST, MDM, NEVADA

CHAINS

The geographic position of the southwest corner of sec. 31, T. 34 N., R. 60 E., is at latitude $40^{\circ} 46' 36.1''$ N. and longitude $115^{\circ} 15' 21.3''$ W., as calculated from U.S.C. & G.S. triangulation station "SECRET," located in sec. 13.

The mean magnetic declination was found to be 17° east.

From the cor. of secs. 35 and 36, on the S. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with an iron post, 2 ins. diam., firmly set in a mound of stone, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of T. 33 N., R. 59 E., executed under Group No. 29.

10.60 Head of ravine, drains NNW.; asc. NE. slope.

22.72 The N $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 2, T. 33 N., R. 59 E., monumented with an iron post, 1 in. diam., firmly set in a mound of stone, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of T. 33 N., R. 59 E., executed under Group No. 29.
