73.43	The cor. of secs. 33 and 34, T. 28 N., R. 43 E., monumented with an iron post, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., firmly set showing 6 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of the S. bdy. of T. 28 N., R. 43 E., executed under Group No. 380. Add the marks 1980 to the brass cap.
81.60	Wash, 15 lks. wide, 3 ft. deep, drains NNE.
81.76	The cor. of secs. 3 and 4, monumented with an iron post, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., firmly set in a mound of stone, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of the S. bdy. of T. 28 N., R. 43 E., executed under Group No. 380. Add the marks 1980 to the brass cap.

36.80	Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 35 and 36, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.
