22.27 The closing cor. of T. 40 N., Rs. 65 and 66 E.,
hereinafter described.

40.15 The original standard $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 36, monumented
with a shaved wooden post, 8 ins. long, 1 in. diam.,
with illegible scribe marks visible, firmly set
alongside a steel fence post.

At the corner point

Set an aluminum post, 30 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24
ins. in the ground, with aluminum cap mkd.
