DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF THE EAST BOUNDARY,
T. 38 N., R. 52½ E., MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN, NEVADA

Reestablishment of the Survey Executed by
T. H. Lowe, U. S. Deputy Surveyor,
in 1900.

The cor. of Tps. 37 and 38 N., R. 52 E., monumented with a basalt stone, 18x12x8 ins., firmly set and exposed 8 ins. above the ground, mkd. with 6 grooves on the N. and W. faces, with a steel fence post, 5½ ft. long, set alongside. Hereafter, this corner now refers to Tps. 37 and 38 N., R. 52½ E. only.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

Deposit the original cornerstone and reset the steel fence post alongside the iron post.

From this corner, the closing cor. of Tps. 37 and 38 N., R. 53 E., monumented with a basalt stone, 16x10x8 ins., firmly set and exposed 10 ins. above the ground, plainly mkd. with 6 grooves on the S., E. and N. faces, and R53 on the SE. face, bears S. 0° 04' E., 6.52 chs. dist.

N. 0° 04' W., along the E. bdy. of sec. 36.

Over gently rolling land, covered with sagebrush and native grass.

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| 6.00 | Trail road, bears E. and W. |
| 30.00 | Coon Creek, 30 lks wide, 1 ft. deep, drains W. |
| 33.48 | Point for the W ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 31, T. 38 N., R. 53 E., at midpoint bet. the closing cors. and on the E. bdy. of sec. 36. |
- Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 4 ins. in the ground to solid rock and in a mound of stone, 5 ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd.
