WEST, on the S. bdy. of sec. 36.

15.23 Intersect the E. bdy. of sec. 36, T. 39 N., R. 52 E.

Point for the closing cor. of Tps. 38 and 39 N., R. 52½ E.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
