From the cor. of secs. 25 and 36, T. 39 N., R. 52½ E., monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., firmly set and exposed 6 ins. above the ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of T. 39 N., R. 53 E., executed under Group Nos. 574 and 585.

WEST, bet. secs. 25 and 36.

14.56 Intersect the E. bdy. of sec. 36, T. 39 N., R. 52 E.

Point for the closing cor. of secs. 25 and 36.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
