No. 2928, Wakefield Mine Lode, at a point from which:</div><div><div>COR. No. 1 of M.S. No. 2928, Mascott Mine Lode, and the place of beginning.</div></div><div><div>GENERAL DESCRIPTION</div><div><p>The area resurveyed within Township 39 North, Range 51 East, varies from nearly level meadow land in the southeast portion to mountainous in the western portion. The elevation ranges from about 5,800 to 6,800 ft. above sea level. The soil consists of sandy clay loam in the lower elevations to rocky in the higher elevations. The vegetation consists of sagebrush and native grass. There are small stands of quaking aspen in the southwest portion.</p><p>A portion of the town of Tuscarora, Nevada is located in section 3. At the time of this survey, there was considerable mining activity in and around Tuscarora. Other users of the township are cattlemen.</p><p>Access into the township is provided by a graded gravel road and supplemented by other improved roads and unimproved trail roads.</p></div></div></div>
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
