From the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 2 and 35, Tps. 36 and 37 N., R. 26 E., monumented with an iron post, 1 in. diam., firmly set in a mound of stone, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the survey and retracement of the N. bdy. of T. 36 N., R. 26 E., executed under Group No. 83.

Remark the brass cap to read as follows:

1920 1981

WEST, bet. secs. 2 and 35.

Over rolling land, covered with scattered sagebrush, shadscale and native grass.

Intersect the E. bdy. of sec. 34, T. 37 N., R. 26 E., concurrently resurveyed under this same Group.

Point for the closing cor. of secs. 2 and 35, Tps. 36 and 37 N., Rs. $26 \ E$.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

1981

Raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, E. of cor.

From this corner, the SE. cor. of sec. 34, hereinafter described, bears S. 1° 30' W., 11.90 chs. dist.

From this same corner, the cor. of secs. 2, 3, 34 and 35, Tps. 36 and 37 N., R. 26 E., established by Emil Voigt in 1920, bears WEST, 7.95 chs. dist., monumented with an iron post, 2 ins. diam., firmly set in a mound of stone, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the retracement of a portion of the N. bdy. of T. 36 N., R. 26 E., executed under Group No. 83. Hereafter, this corner will function as an amended monument.
