Reestablishment of the Resurvey Executed by
Emil Voigt, U. S. Cadastral Engineer,
in 1920.

From the E $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 3, monumented with an iron post, 1 in. diam., firmly set in a mound of stone, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of a portion of the subdivisional lines of T. 36 N., R. 26 E., executed under Group No. 83.

Remark the brass cap to read as follows:
