

TOWNSHIP 37 NORTH, RANGE 26 EAST, MDM, NEVADA

CHAINS

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The area resurveyed within Township 37 North, Range 26 East, varies from mountainous in the east portion to nearly level in the southwest portion with the remaining terrain being gently rolling. The elevation ranges from about 3,000 to 4,500 ft. above sea level. The soil varies from sandy alkali and sandy clay loam in the lower elevations to rocky in the higher elevations. The vegetation consists of shadscale, sagebrush, rabbitbrush, greasewood, Brigham tea, and native grasses.

Hardin City (an abandoned millsite consisting of some crumbled stone foundations) and two hot springs are situated in section 10. A spring is located in each of sections 5 and 29. There are mining claims located in the mountainous parts. The principal users of the township are people looking for semi-precious stones raising cattle.

Access to the township consists of rough trail roads and is very limited with the quickest way in from the south across the Black Rock Desert being cut off in the fall and winter when it rains.
