TOWNSHIP 46 NORTH, RANGE 33 EAST, MDM, NEVADA CHAINS The land within Township 46 North, Range 33 East is about 4,000 to 6,000 ft. above sea level and is gently rolling land. The soil is sandy clay loam, and is covered with sagebrush, rabbitbrush and native grass. There is an improved gravel road crossing from west to east in the  $S\frac{1}{2}$  of sec. 36. A powerline enters the township on the east boundary of sec. 36 and leaves in sec. 25. Numerous private fences are located within secs. 25 and 36. Principal users of the area are ranchers for the growing of alfalfa and the grazing of cattle.
