N. 1° 13' W., bet. secs. 31 and 36.

Over rolling reseeded land, through crested wheatgrass.

40.17 The original $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 31 and 36, monumented with the decayed remains of a shaved wooden post, 6 ins. long, 1 in. diam., with illegible scribe marks visible, firmly set 5 ins. in the ground, with a steel fence post alongside.

At the corner point

Set an aluminum post, 30 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with aluminum cap mkd.

40.25 The original cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36, monumented with the decayed remains of a squared wooden post in pieces, with illegible scribe marks visible, loosely set in a mound of earth, with a steel fence post alongside.

Set an aluminum post, 30 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with aluminum cap mkd.
