## GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The land within Township 20 North, Range 54 East is about 6,000 to 8,200 ft. above sea level and rolling to mountainous land. The soil is sandy clay loam along the bottom land and rocky in the higher elevations. The land is covered with medium sagebrush and juniper, scattered pinon pine, buckbrush, serviceberry brush, cacti and native grass.

Numerous trail roads run throughout the township.

U.S.G.S. Bench Marks are located in sections 5, 17, and 28.

A powerline enters the township on the W. bdy. of sec. 7 and runs through secs. 7, 8, and ends in sec. 9.

Numerous private fences are located throughout the  $\ensuremath{\text{Tp}}_{\:\raisebox{1pt}{\text{\circle*{1.5}}}}$ 

Principal use of the area is for cattle grazing.

A number of ranches are located within the township.
