CHAINS

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The land within Township 24 North, Range 37 East, ranges from about 3,400 to 4,800 ft. above sea level, and is nearly level to rolling. The soil is sandy clay, alkali, gravelly and rocky. The vegetation consists of greasewood.

The township is drained by Spring Creek which winds south through the western portion of the township.

The Lamb Ranch is located in section 7. There are hot wells located in sections 5, 7, and 21 and three in section 18. There are two irrigation wells in section 11.

Principal users of the area are cattlemen. Access into the township is provided by improved and unimproved roads.

No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the survey.
