T. 37 N., R. 46 E., MDM, NEVADA

CHAINS

Deposit the original cornerstone and set a steel fence post, 5½ ft. long, alongside the aluminum post.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The land within Township 37 North, Range 46 East is about 4,900 to 6,200 ft. above sea level and is rolling to mountainous land. The soil is sandy clay loam along the bottom land and rocky on the high elevations. The land is covered with sagebrush and native grass except along the river bottom which is covered with meadow grass.

There are numerous trail roads throughout the township.

Principal users of the area are cattle ranchers.

There were no mineral formations of consequence noted, during this survey.
