39.16	<p>Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 2, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.</p> <p>Set an aluminum post, 30 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with aluminum cap mkd.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">T38N R47E $\frac{1}{4}$ S 2 S 1</p> <p style="text-align: center;">1981</p>
65.20	<p>Set a steel fence post, $5\frac{1}{2}$ ft. long, alongside the aluminum post and raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, W. of cor.</p> <p>Trail road, bears NNW. and SSE.</p>
78.64	<p>The cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36, on the N. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with an aluminum post, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., firmly set showing 6 ins. above ground, with aluminum cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of T. 39 N., R. 47 E., executed concurrently under this same Group.</p> <hr/> <p>From the cor. of secs. 2, 3, 34 and 35, on the S. bdy. of the Tp.</p> <p>N. $0^{\circ} 56'$ E., bet. secs. 34 and 35.</p> <p>Over rolling land, covered with sagebrush and native grass.</p>

22.20	Wash, 25 lks. wide, 1 ft. deep, drains W.
