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GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The land within Township 38 North, Range 47 East is about 5,100 to 6,400 ft. above sea level and is rolling to mountainous land. The soil is sandy clay loam along the bottom land and rocky on the high elevations. The land is covered with sagebrush and native grass except along the creek bottom which is covered with meadow grass.

There are numerous trail roads through the township.

The confluence of Rock Creek and Willow Creek is in sec. 18. Willow Creek enters the township in sec. 2 and Rock Creek enters in sec. 5 and leaves in sec. 31.

Principal users of the area are ranchers and farmers.

Some mining activity was noted in the southeastern portion of the township.

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
