TOWNSHIP 1 SOUTH, RANGE 40 $\frac{1}{2}$ EAST, MDM, NEVADA

CHAINS

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The land within Township 1 South, Range 40 $\frac{1}{2}$ East is mountainous in the western half with elevations between 5,300 and 5,950 ft. above sea level and gently rolling in the eastern half with elevations between 4,800 and 5,300 ft. above sea level. The soil is gravelly with volcanic rocks in the mountains and gravelly with some sand in the eastern part. The undergrowth consists of sagebrush and scattered cacti.

There are several trail roads crossing from east to west, extending only to the foothills.

Principal users of the area consist of mining enthusiasts, as there is evidence of numerous prospects throughout the township.

There are no improvements within the township.
