N. 1° 08' E., beginning new measurement.

Over gently rolling land.

39.98 Intersect the S. bdy. of sec. 36, T. 1 S., R. 40 E.

Point for the NE. closing cor. of the Tp., at proportionate distance, there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an aluminum post, 30 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with aluminum cap mkd.

40.07 Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 35 and 36, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an aluminum post, 30 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with aluminum cap mkd.
