CHAINS

The land within Township 1 South, Range 40 East is nearly level in the southern half with elevations between 4,250 and 4,500 ft. and mountainous in the northern half and east boundary with elevations between 4,500 and 6,000 ft. The soil is sandy and alkali in the southern half and gravelly with volcanic rocks in the mountains. The undergrowth consists of scattered sagebrush and cacti in the mountains with no vegetation on the sandy alkali flat.

There is an improved graded road crossing from west to east, entering in sec. 31 and leaving in sec. 35. There are two other improved graded roads branching from this main one, heading northerly - one, beginning in sec. 30 and leaving in sec. 6, the other beginning in sec. 23 and leaving in sec. 1.

Principle users of the area consist of mining enthusiasts, as there is evidence of numerous prospects throughout the township.

The southern, flat area contains the very northern edge of a large lithium mining project which is evidenced by a large leaching pond, several abandoned wells, and one producing well.
