From the N.  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of sec. 2, monumented with an iron post, 1 in. diam., firmly set, showing 6 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the survey of the north boundary, T. 21 N., R. 47 E., executed under Group No. 91.

Remark the brass cap to read as follows:

Over nearly level land, covered with scattered sagebrush.

34.78 The closing cor. of secs. 34 and 35, T. 22 N., R. 47 E., monumented with an aluminum post,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., firmly set, showing 6 ins. above ground, with aluminum cap mkd. as described in the field notes of T. 22 N., R. 47 E., concurrently resurveyed under this same Group.

40.11 The cor. of secs. 2 and 3, monumented with an iron post, 2 ins. diam., firmly set, showing 6 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the resurvey of the north boundary, T. 21 N., R. 47 E., executed under Group No. 91.
