Reestablishment of a Portion of the Survey
and Independent Resurvey Executed by
G. W. Ridgway, U.S. Cadastral Engineer, and
Edie S. C. Smith, U.S. Transitman, in 1923 and 1924.

From the cor. of secs. 2, 3, 10 and 11, monumented with
an iron post, 2 ins. diam., firmly set in a mound of
stone, showing 12 ins. above ground, with brass cap
mkd. as described in the field notes of the
subdivisional lines of T. 21 N., R. 47 E., executed
under Group No. 91.

N. 0° 10' W., bet. secs. 2 and 3.

Over gently rolling land, covered with scattered
sagebrush.

The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 2 and 3, monumented with an
iron post, 1 in. diam., firmly set in a mound of stone,
showing 12 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd. as
described in the field notes of the subdivisional lines
of T. 21 N., R. 47 E., executed under Group No. 91.
