Raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, S. of cor.

From this corner, the S.  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of sec. 31, T. 22 N., R. 47 E., monumented with an aluminum post,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., firmly set, showing 6 ins. above ground, with aluminum cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of T. 22 N., R. 47 E., executed concurrently under this same Group, bears S. 88° 49' E., 1.48 chs. dist.

From this same corner, the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 6 and 7, is calculated to bear S. 0° 02' E.

From this same corner, the N. ½ sec. cor. of sec. 6, monumented with an iron post, 1 in. diam., firmly set, showing 8 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of T. 21 N., R. 47 E., executed under Group No. 91, bears, N. 0 02' W., 0.79 chs. dist. Hereafter, this cor. will function as an amended monument.

Add the marks AM and 1982 to the brass cap.

The S.  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of sec. 31, T. 22 N., R. 47 E., monumented with an iron post, 1 in. diam., firmly set, showing 8 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of T. 21 N., R. 47 E., executed under Group No. 91, bears S. 89° 56' E., 0.91 chs. dist. Hereafter, this cor. will function as an amended mounment.

Add the marks AM and 1982 to the brass cap.

## GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The land within the area resurveyed is about 5,700 to 5,900 ft. above sea level and is rolling to mountainous land. The soil is sandy clay loam along the bottom land and rocky on the higher elevations. The land is covered with sagebrush and native grass.

Access into the township is provided by a graded gravel road that enters the township in sec. 6 and leaves in sec. 6.
