The cor. of Tps. 21 and $21\frac{1}{2}$ N., Rs. 53 and 54 E., determined latitudinally in line with a fence to the west and longitudinally 30 ft. E. of the corner of the right of way fences bearing W. and S. The position for the cor. falls in a paved road bearing N. and S. There is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set a $\frac{1}{4}$ in. steel bolt, 3 ins. long, flush with the road surface; from which

An iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., set 24 ins. in the ground, for a reference monument, bears S. 66° 34' E., 100 lks. dist., with brass cap mkd. T 21 N R 54 E S 6 RM 1983 66 ft. and an arrow pointing to the cor.

S. 88° 07' W., along the north boundary of sec. 1.

Over nearly level land, covered with scattered sagebrush; along fence.

19.83 The S. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 1, T. $21\frac{1}{2}$ N., R. 53 E., hereinafter described.

The ½ sec. cor. of sec. 1, monumented with an iron post, 1 in. diam., firmly set and showing 6 ins. above ground, and in an E. and W. fence line, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of the north boundary of T. 21 N., R. 53 E., executed under Group No. 133.
