CHAINS	SOUTH, bet. secs. 1 and 6.
	Over nearly level land, covered with scattered sagebrush.
10.90	Trail road, bears NW. and SE.
33.87	Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 6.
	Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

	Set a steel fence post, $5\frac{1}{2}$ ft. long, alongside the iron post.
