<div>CHAINS</div> <div>6.25</div>	<div>Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.</div> <div><div>T22N R52E</div><div>S 18</div><div>COR 4</div><div>BMS</div><div>MS 38B</div></div> <div>1983</div> <div>Set a steel fence post, 5½ ft. long, alongside the iron post.</div> <div>Thence SOUTH</div> <div>Cor. No. 1 of the Batchelder Mill Site of M.S. No. 38B, identical with Cor. No. 1 of the Good Hope Mill Site of M.S. No. 37B, and place of beginning.</div> <div>GENERAL DESCRIPTION</div> <div>The land within Township 22 North, Range 52 East, ranges from about 5,860 to 7,840 ft. above sea level. The soil is rocky in the mountains and sandy clay loam at the lower elevations. The undergrowth consists of sagebrush, cheatgrass, crested wheat grass, Brigham tea, juniper, pinon pine and mountain mahogany.</div> <div>Nevada State Highway No. 278, enters the Tp. on the S. bdy. of sec. 35 and leaves the Tp. on the N. bdy. of sec. 6.</div> <div>There are a few trail roads within the Tp.</div> <div>A windmill is located in sec. 16.</div> <div>An abandoned railroad grade is visible in some places, S. of the State Highway.</div> <div>Some mining activity is located in secs. 8 and 18.</div> <div>Principal users of the area are ranchers and miners.</div>
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
