	<p>S. 0° 02' W., along the E. bdy. of sec. 1.</p>
	<p>Over nearly level land, covered with scattered sagebrush.</p>
2.28	<p>The closing cor. of T. 21½ N., R. 51½ E. and T. 21 N., R. 52 E., monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., firmly set and showing 4 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of T. 21½ N., R. 51½ E., executed concurrently under this same Group.</p>
40.21	<p>The ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 6, monumented with a wooden post 4X4 ins., 3 ft. long, loosely set in a mound of earth, with scribing dimly visible. Hereafter, this corner will refer to sec. 1, only.</p>
	<p>At the corner point</p>
	<p>Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.</p>

	<p>Bury the original wooden post and set a steel fence post, 5 ft. long, alongside the iron post.</p>
