GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The land within Township 23 North, Range 39 East is about 4,200 to 6,700 ft. above sea level and is rolling to mountainous land. The soil is sandy clay loam along the bottom land and rocky on the middle to upper elevations. The land is covered with sagebrush and native grass except along the upper elevations which is covered with juniper and pinon pine.

There is a graded gravel road crossing from south to north, entering in sec. 36 and leaving in sec. 3.

Principal users of the area are ranchers.

There were no mineral formations or activity noted in the township.
