

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF A PORTION OF THE EAST BOUNDARY,

40.00

The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 6, monumented with a limestone, 18X10X8 ins., firmly set 10 ins. in a mound of earth, mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ on W. face, with a steel fence post alongside.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

Deposit the original cornerstone and reset the steel fence post, 5 ft. long, alongside the iron post.

N. $0^{\circ} 03'$ W., beginning new measurement.

Over nearly level land.

- 21.30 Fence, bears NW. and SE.
- 21.38 Intersect right-of-way Interstate Highway No. 80, bears N. $37^{\circ} 05'$ W. and S. $37^{\circ} 05'$ E.
- 26.30 Center line of East bound lane of Interstate Highway No. 80, parallels right-of-way.
- 36.70 Center line of West bound lane of Interstate Highway No. 80, parallels right-of-way.
- 40.02 The cor. of Tps. 34 and 35 N., Rs. 68 and 69 E.

- 11.80 Trail road, bears SW. and NE.
- 13.80 Trail road, bears irregularly E. and W.
- 25.20 Dry wash, 14 lks. wide, 4 ft. deep, drains NE.
- 26.30 Trail road, bears irregularly WSW. and ENE.
- 34.52 The closing cor. of secs. 7 and 18, T. 34 N., R. 69 E., hereinafter described.
