Land; nearly level.

Undergrowth; sagebrush and native grass.

N.  $89^{\circ} 57'$  W., bet. secs. 2 and 35, on a transit line describing the tangent.

Over nearly level land, covered with sagebrush and native grass.

39.99 Point for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 2 and 35, NORTH, 1.1 lks. from the tangent.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

From the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 4 and 9, monumented with the remains of broken glass found 6 ins. below the surface of the ground and the remains of two shallow pits, 4 ft. E. and W: Hereafter, this corner will refer to sec. 4 only.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
