

TOWNSHIP 34 NORTH, RANGE 69 EAST, MDM, NEVADA

CHAINS

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The land within Township 34 North, Range 69 East is about 4,300 to 5,400 ft. above sea level and is nearly level to rolling land. The soil is sandy clay loam and rocky. The vegetation consists of sagebrush and native grass.

Interstate Highway No. 80 crossing northwesterly to southeasterly, enters in sec. 6 and leaves in sec. 35. Other access is provided by numerous desert trail roads.

The Western Pacific Railroad crossing from northwest to southeast, enters in sec. 19 and leaves in sec. 34.

The township drains in a northeasterly direction.

There were no mineral formations noted throughout the survey.

Principal users of the area are cattlemen.
