N. 0° 13' W., beginning new measurement.

An aspen, 10 ins. diam., bears S. 22° W., 5 lks. dist., mkd. T16N R64E S24 BT.

A fir, 24 ins. diam., bears N. $1\frac{1}{2}$ ° W., 19 lks. dist., mkd. T16N R64E S13 BT.
