

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF THE SUBDIVISIONAL LINES,
T. 47 N., R. 66 E., MDM, NEVADA

CHAINS

Raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, S. of cor.

This corner is located 17 lks. N. of a fence, bearing E. and W.

From this corner, Mile Post No. 25, hereinbefore described, bears S. 89° 52' W., 22.74 chs. dist.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The land within Township 47 North, Range 66 East is about 5,300 to 7,600 ft. above sea level and is rolling to mountainous land. The soil is sandy clay loam, and rocky at the higher elevations. The land is covered with scattered sagebrush and native grass except along the creek bottoms which contains chokecherry and sparse aspen.

There is a bladed road crossing from SW. to NE., entering in sec. 30 and leaving in sec. 1. There are several trail roads providing access to many parts of the township.

Shoshone Creek enters in sec. 6 and leaves in sec. 7.
Horse Creek forms in sec. 34 and leaves in sec. 3.
Indian Mike Creek forms in sec. 36 and leaves in sec. 1.
West Basin Draw forms in sec. 35 and leaves in sec. 1.

Principal users of the area are ranchers.
