

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF THE SUBDIVISIONAL LINES,

CHAINS

Point for the closing cor. of secs. 5 and 6, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an aluminum post, 30 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 20 ins. in the ground to bedrock and in a mound of stone to cap, 3 ft. base, with aluminum cap mkd.

From this corner, Mile Post No. 43, hereinbefore described, bears S. $86^{\circ} 20'$ W., 25.48 chs. dist.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The land within Township 47 North, Range 63 East, ranges from about 5700 to 7200 ft. above sea level, and is rolling to mountainous. The soil is sandy clay, gravelly and rocky. The vegetation consists of sagebrush, bunchgrass, mahogany and aspen.

The township is drained by Cottonwood Creek, which winds northeasterly through the southeast portion of the township.

The Browns Bench Ranch is located in section 3.

No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the survey.

Principal users of the area are cattlemen. Access into the township is provided by desert trail roads throughout the township.
