TOWNSHIP 41 NORTH, RANGE 48 EAST, MDM, NEVADA **CHAINS** GENERAL DESCRIPTION The land within Township 41 North, Range 48 East, ranges from about 5,600 to 7,400 ft. above sea level, and is gently rolling to mountainous. The soil varies from sandy clay and gravely in the lower land to rocky in the higher elevations. The vegetation consists of sagebrush and native grass. The area is drained by numerous creeks and dry washes, draining northerly through the township. Principal users of the area are cattlemen. Access into the township is provided by improved and unimproved No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the survey.
